

DOG FOULING

As the weather is getting better members of the village have raised concern again at the number of dog walking residents who do not pick up their dog's waste. This is occurring all over the village, including Council maintained public areas and other locations being maintained by village residents.

Everyone should be aware that the Borough Council of King's Lynn and West Norfolk are responsible for enforcing the law around dog owners responsibility to collect their dog fouling waste. Individuals can be reported using the website below:

While generally unpleasant for everyone walking around the village and using public spaces and footpaths, diseases can also be transmitted by pet waste including: Campylobacteriosis – bacterial infection that causes diarrhoea in humans (carried by dogs and cats) and Cryptosporidium a parasitic infection that causes diarrhoea and abdominal distress (carried by dogs and cats).

Please ensure if you are a dog walker that you collect all your waste and either take it home or dispose in one of the dog waste bins provided by the Council around the village.

We all love walking around Southery, whether we have a dog or not, so please help keep our open spaces clean and tidy and a pleasure for everyone to enjoy.

Streetlight Lynn Road – New Column and Light – The Council received settlement from the insurers for the light and UK power networks costs for just over £1700.00. The Clerk instructed the Council's contractor to progress the work. Planning Applications received between meetings

22/00259/F Erection of Single Storey extension to the side and rear of the property 73 A Feltwell Road. No comments returned on 26.03.22

22/00315/F Solar Panels on Barn Roof 71B Feltwell Road, Southery. No comments returned on 05.04.22

45/22 To Note Any Councillors Concerns or items for next meeting and note forward work programme.

Apologies was received from Cllr Martin Storey.

- Dyke on Campsey Road A resident was going to liaise with NCC direct.
- The Clerk agreed to ask the Handyman to reinstate the bin on Campsey Road.
- The Clerk agreed to email the Police to see if they could do anything about cars parking on the junction from Campsey Road that joins within Feltwell Road.
- · The surface sign was now gone on Feltwell Road.
- The Clerk agreed to update with Cllr Martin Storey on Campsey Road drain and Lions Court Ditch.
- · It was noted that there had been reported speeding vehicles down Campsey Road.
- The Clerk agreed to arrange for a 'No Dogs Allowed' sign to be added to the Cemetery gates
- The Clerk agreed to chase Feltwell FC for return of keys.

46/22 To Note Works Completed in March and to Approve Any Handyman Work for April 2022 That work as in the basic schedule for April be approved including the installation of a second fence on the playing field.

The beacon was to be added to the official website; there was a proclamation to be read and music to be played. The organisers are going to do a poster for the event, and this will be included. The times will be discussed outside the meeting.

RESOLVED: It was agreed to total Cost £874.72 plus VAT so 144 in total or £5.88 each be ordered to give out at the Thursday WI event including costs for a flower arrangement. (Proposed Cllr Javey Osler, Seconded Cllr Chris Edwards, all were in favour).

48/22 To Approve Norfolk County Council Parish Partnership Fund 2022/23 Fund to Install a Trod Footpath on Feltwell Road

It was noted that Cllr Martin Storey had allocated £2k from his Norfolk County Council budget towards the PC's share.

RESOLVED: That contribution of 50% to the Parish Partnership Fund project to install a trod on Feltwell Road at a cost of £10,375 to Norfolk County Council who will carry out the work. (Proposed Cllr Crispin Copsey, Seconded Cllr Javey Osler, all were in favour)

49/22 To Approve Any Action of Costs Arising from the Southery Play Area and Skate Ramp Reports

The Clerk agreed to investigate with the Handyman mastic of the tile gaps.

RESOLVED: That work to the cost of £413.40 to replace swing chains be approved as within the annual play area inspection report, and the grounds maintenance contractor be requested to spray the play area floor tiles with mould spray. (Proposed Cllr Christine Feltwell, Seconded Cllr Annette Osler, all were in favour).

50/22 To Discuss Update on Orchard Way Streetlights Adoption

The Clerk agreed to add to the May agenda to approve adoption of the lights.

51/22 To Approve that the Southery Parish Council Create and Maintain a Household Support Register

The Council did not wish to action this currently.

52/22 To Approve Change of Battery Charging Regime from Three to Every Two Weeks All were in favour of this change.

53/22 To Review and Approve Any Change to the Frequency of Litter Bin Emptying RESOLVED: That the Werehen bin be amended to be emptied fortnightly instead of weekly and the Campsey Road bin weekly instead of fortnightly. All were in favour.

54/22 To Approve Any Response to Planning Consultation Received: 22/00169/F Change of Use of Paddock to garden and siting of a caravan at 17 Lynn Road, Southery, PE38 0HU RESOLVED: They object to the application on the following grounds:

- Loss of green space within the Parish once it has been changed to a garden from a paddock and which has a negative impact on the environment.
- The Parish Council is unclear how many caravans there are proposed, in the last application
 it was stated a static caravan and, in this application, just a caravan where one is permanent,
 and one isn't. This needs clarification.
- The presence of a caravan is a potential nuisance to neighbouring properties in terms of noise and activity.
- there is potentially more traffic from the property with an additional residence being the caravan in place which is a highway concern.
- The piece of land is outside of the development boundary and the PC feel this should not change by way of a planning decision through this application or as result of. It would not wish that by way of approving this application it then has an implication to allow development on land outside the development boundary.

And The PC also wished to add the following point that it is understood the siting of the caravan will be temporary and if granted by BCKLWN the PC would be requesting that this be the case as a planning condition, that it be a temporary arrangement and not permanent

All were in favour.






